



## **Volunteer Position: Volunteer Clinical Supervisor**

**Area/Program Focus:** Mental Health and Violence Prevention Services

**Position Summary:** Catholic Charities is seeking Licensed Clinical Social Workers (LCSW) and Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists (LMFT) who meet Board of Behavioral Sciences (BBS) regulatory requirements to provide clinical supervision. This volunteer position will help to mentor and prepare emerging mental health professionals grow and develop as they complete clinical hours and work toward licensure; the volunteer clinical supervisor never interacts directly with the client (no observational or recorded methods are used at Catholic Charities). Clinical supervision is a form of training for licensure based on a discussion of actual cases. The duration of each clinical supervision arrangement will be determined by the requirements associated with the clinician's licensure process. Catholic Charities strives to match clinical supervisors with clinicians based on interests and experience.

The Volunteer Clinical Supervisor will provide clinical supervision to AMFT and ASW staff that require at least one hour of individual clinical supervision weekly. Clinical supervision does not include programmatic or administrative supervisory duties. The volunteer clinical supervisor reports to the Clinical Manager and refers any concerns regarding the supervisee to the Clinical Manager who consults with the Program Manager of the relevant program.

### **Qualifications/Requirements:**

- Possesses a master's degree from an accredited professional school of social work or university preparing students for California licensure as an LCSW, MFT or psychologist.
- Possesses a license as an LCSW, MFT, or psychologist.
- Complete and maintain necessary certification and professional development needed for clinical supervision.
- 2 or more years of experience delivering or supervising the delivery of trauma treatment mental health services
- Fingerprinting and background check with clearance to work with children and youth

### **Time Commitment Needed**

Catholic Charities requests that interested applicants commit to one hour of face-to-face supervision for each intern s/he agrees to supervise. While we understand that there may be times that supervision may have to be cancelled, we ask that volunteers try to minimize this where possible and keep the Clinical Manager informed about planned or emergency cancellations.
