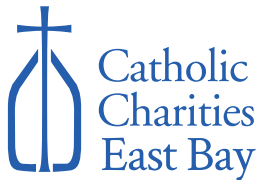

STORM ASSISTANCE FOR IMMIGRANTS (SAI)

DISASTER RELIEF CASE MANAGEMENT AND DIRECT ASSISTANCE

Storm Assistance for Immigrants (SAI) is a state-funded program to provide disaster relief case management and direct assistance to eligible, individuals who were affected by the storms from December 2022 through April 2023 and are ineligible for federal assistance.

HURRY, FUNDING IS LIMITED.

SAI assistance is provided on a first-come, first-served basis.

WHO CAN APPLY

- Individuals who are ineligible for federal assistance welcome
- Eligible categories: Legal status not required, DACA, Asylum seekers, U-Visa pending, & more
- Residents of Contra Costa and Alameda County*
- Must have suffered a hardship due to storms in California, December 2022 to April 2023

California Department of Social Services **Storm Assistance for Immigrants (SAI)**

In response to the series of storms across California in December 2022 through April 2023, the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) is providing state-funded storm recovery services to provide disaster relief case management and direct assistance to eligible individuals who experienced hardship from the storms and cannot access federal assistance due to immigration status.

Direct assistance payments will be provided for the purpose of helping storm impacted individuals and households cover certain necessary costs including housing, food, and transportation costs.

Storm recovery services are available in California counties where the President has issued a Major Disaster Declaration and approved Individual Assistance (IA) in those counties because of impact from the storms. Additional counties may be added as they receive IA declarations and if there is provider capacity to deliver services in those areas.
